

Outer Cover

Prevents the rain from getting in the hive

Inner Cover

Used for feeding, as a top entrance and to control ventilation

Honey Super

Bee box that the bees store honey in

Queen Excluder

Creates a barrier between the queen's brood & the honey supers

Brood Chamber

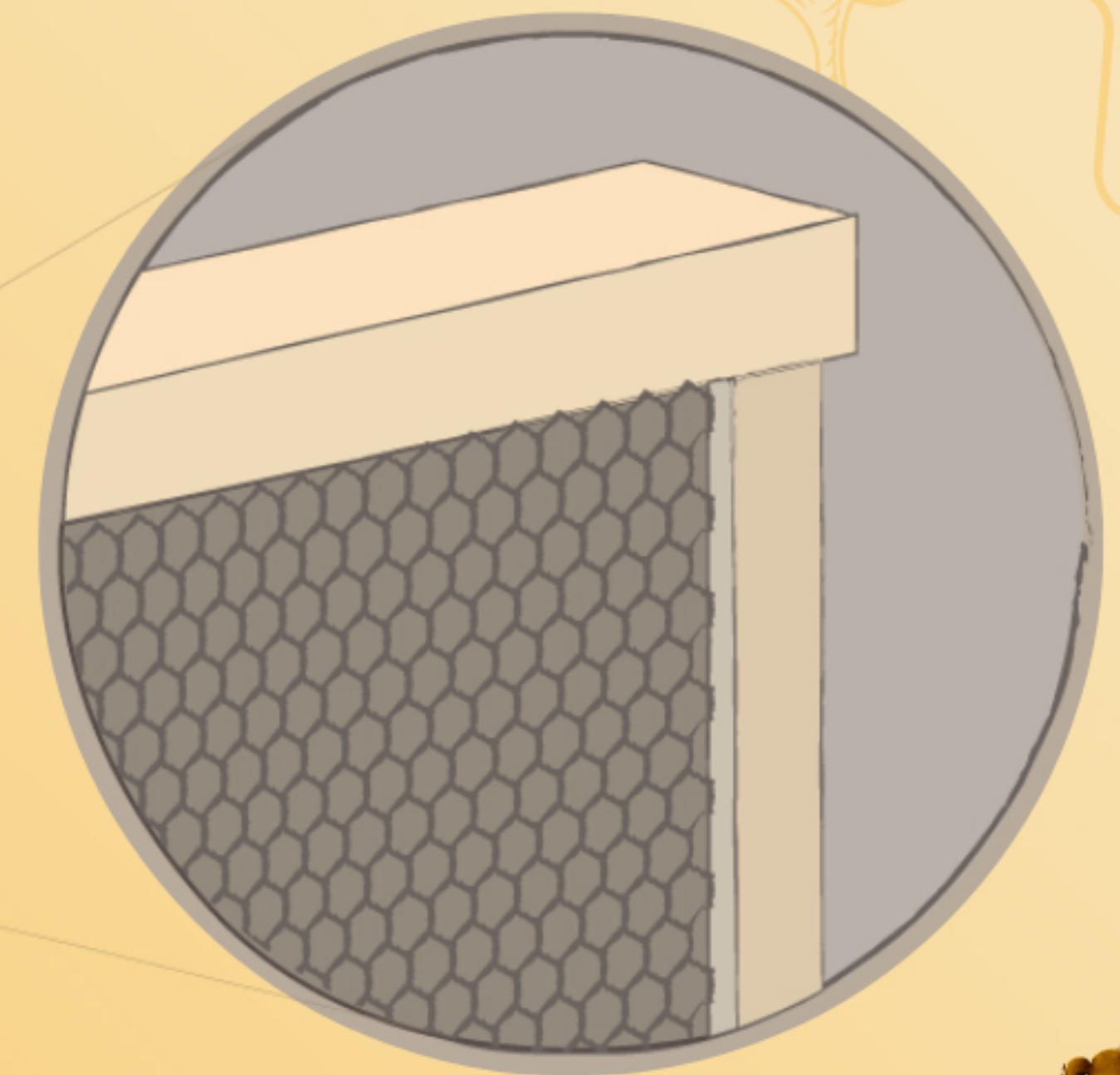
Bee box that the queen lays her brood eggs in

Bottom Board

Protects the entire hive from small predators like mice and shrews

Hive Stand

Bears the weight of the entire hive
